The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has completed review of the Remedial Action Work Plan received on September 22, 2010. The Department provides the following comments on the Work Plan.

The Remedial Action Work Plan was submitted by Millington Quarry, Inc. apparently without the concurrence of Tilcon. Millington Quarry and Tilcon are joint signatories of the Memorandum of Agreement for this site. At the time of submission, the Department was in discussion with JM Sorge, Inc for completion of the second phase of soil sampling required for the characterization of the fill material. The Department is reviewing the Work Plan for the second phase of soil sampling and will be issuing a letter on the Work Plan in the near future.

The September 22, 2010 Remedial Action Work Plan discusses the results of the first phase of soil sampling and proposes construction of a cap for the fill. Due to the incomplete characterization of the fill located at the site, proposals for the construction of a cap at the site is premature at this time. Once phase II of the fill sampling is completed, the Department will review the result and all parties will be in a better position to determine if any additional sampling is warranted and/or what type of capping may be appropriate for the site
